

Friends of the Multi Arts Center, Inc.
BYLAWS

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this organization shall be **Friends of Multi Arts Center, Inc.**

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

The purpose of this charitable organization is to promote and support the Stillwater Multi Arts Center. This said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP & DUES

Categories of membership and dues shall be determined by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV. MEETINGS

Meetings of the general membership shall be held twice yearly. The date, time, and location will be determined by the Board of Directors. Additional meetings of the general membership may be called by the Board of Directors as needed.

ARTICLE V. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall be composed of officers and board members. The Board of Directors shall be composed of no more than sixteen (16) members including the officers. The Board of Directors shall be members in good standing.

ARTICLE VI. OFFICERS

Friends of Multi Arts Center, Inc. shall have officers to include President, President-elect, Past President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Officers are elected on a yearly basis from within the board for a one-year term and cannot hold that office for more than two consecutive terms.

ARTICLE VII. COMMITTEES

Committees shall be defined by the Board of Directors, as necessary, for carrying out the activities of the organization.

ARTICLE VIII. AMENDMENTS

Written notice of any proposed changes to the Bylaws must be submitted to the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors must provide written or electronic notification to the general membership thirty (30) days prior to any vote. The Bylaws may be amended by a simple majority vote of the members in good standing present at a general membership meeting or by electronic communication.

ARTICLE IX. OPERATION

Friends of Multi Arts Center, Inc. shall operate in accordance with the Operational Procedures developed by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE X. DISSOLUTION

Dissolution is governed by the laws of the State of Oklahoma.
